ORDINANCE NO. 6737

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as South Lake Fenwick Annexation to King County Water District No. 75.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as South Lake Fenwick Annexation to King County Water
 District No. 75 was filed with the County Council effective
 February 23, 1984
- 2. King County Water District No. 75 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution Nos. 83-11-2 A and 84-1-18 B concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. King County Water District No. 75 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated November 1, 1983, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The County Council held a public hearing on the $\frac{26 \text{ Hz}}{26 \text{ Hz}}$ day of $\frac{26 \text{ Hz}}{26 \text{ Hz}}$, 19 $\frac{84}{26 \text{ Hz}}$ and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 75 of the area known as South Lake Fenwick Annexation and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation report on South Lake Fenwick Annexation.

SECTION 2. King County Water District No. 75 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute County approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.
