ORDINANCE NO. **6738**

AN ORDINANCE adopting the sewerage general plan for the County operated Skyway Sewer Service area under the provisions of RCW 36.94 and KCC 20.12.030.

PREAMBLE:

The Council of King County has declared it advisable and necessary to prepare a sewer general plan for sewer service to the Skyway area of the County.

A comprehensive sewerage plan, entitled "Sewerage General Plan - Skyway" dated May 1981 and revised on August 11, 1981, has been prepared. The Skyway Sewer Area Subcommittee of the King County Sewerage General Plan Review Committee reviewed the plan and, on August 11, 1981, recommended that it be approved in accordance with Chapter 36.94 RCW.

Sewer service to this area is consistent with the King County Sewerage General Plan.

On June 4, 1981 King County filed a Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed reorganization of the Skyway sewer service area pursuant to RCW 36.94.

As required by RCW 36.94, the Metro Council on Oct. 1, 1981, approved the Skyway Sewerage General Plan by Resolution No.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The "Sewerage General Plan - Skyway," dated May 1981, revised August 11, 1981, (attached) is hereby adopted as

1 an amendment to Chapter 7 of the King County Sewerage General
2 Plan pursuant to Chapter 36.94 RCW and as an element to the
3 comprehensive plan for King County under the provisions of
4 KCC 20.12.030. The Sewerage General Plan for the County operated
5 Skyway sewer system is an amplification and augmentation of the
6 County Comprehensive Plan, as provided in Chapter 7 of the King
7 County Sewerage General Plan.
