ORDINANCE NO. 6748

AN ORDINANCE providing for the issuance of bond anticipation warrants in the amount of \$2,700,000

for Road Improvement District No. 91 to Rainier

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National Bank pursuant to Ordinance No. 6503 and RCW 39.50; and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE:
By Ordinance No. 6503, 1) the county created Road Improvement District No. 91 (the "RID"), 2) created the RID 91 Construction Fund and 3) authorized the issuance of interest

bearing warrants pursuant to RCW 36.88.330 against such fund. Pursuant to RCW 39.50 the county is authorized, among other things to borrow money in anticipation of the receipt of the sale of bonds for local improvement districts and RCW

39.50.030 requires approval of such borrowing by ordinance.

The council has determined it is in the best interests of the county that the terms and provisions of such warrants and an offer for their purchase be approved.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing interim financing for RID No. 91, Rainier National Bank will purchase a Bond Anticipation Warrant from King County RID Construction Fund (hereafter referred to as "Warrant") in the amount of \$2,700,000. The proceeds of the Warrant shall be used to pay for the costs of the improvements ordered by Ordinance No. 6503.

SECTION 2. The Warrant shall mature December 31, 1985, and shall be fully registered in the name of Rainier National Bank. The principal balance of the Warrant shall be due at maturity. The county may elect to prepay all or any portion of the principal and accrued interest on the Warrant at any time upon ten business days notice to Rainier National Bank. Interest shall be computed on the principal balance of the Warrant from its date of delivery until its prepayment or maturity at a rate determined by computing sixty-four percent (64%) of the publicly announced prime rate of Rainier National Bank. The interest rate will be adjusted daily in accordance with changes in such prime

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Interest will be calculated on the basis of a 365-day year and shall be payable on the last business day of each calendar quarter on the basis of statements received from the registered owner of the Warrant.

SECTION 3. Both principal of and interest on the Warrant shall be payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the office of the director of finance of King County in Seattle, Washington and shall be obligations only of the King County RID Construction Fund.

SECTION 4. There has been created heretofore a special fund known as the King County RID No. 91 Construction Fund (the "Fund").

By Ordinance No. 6503, the county has convenanted that it will authorize the issuance of bonds sufficient to redeem outstanding warrants of the Fund after the completion of the improvements, the confirmation of the final assessment roll and expiration of the thirty-day period for payment of assessments without penalty or interest.

SECTION 5. The Warrant shall be substantially the following form:

King County, Washington, acknowledges itself to owe and for value received promises to pay to Rainier National Bank the principal amount of \$2,700,000 plus accrued interest, in full, on or before December 31, 1985. Interest shall be computed from the date hereon to the date of prepayment or maturity at a rate determined by computing sixty-four percent (74%) of the publicly announced prime rate of Rainier National Bank. The interest rate will be adjusted daily in accordance with changes in such prime rate. Interest will be calculated on the basis of a 365-day year and shall be payable on the last business day of each calendar quarter on the basis of statements received from the registered owner of the Warrant.

The county may elect to prepay all or any portion of the principal and accrued interest at any time upon ten business days notice to Rainier National Bank.

Both principal of and interest are payable in lawful money of

the United States of America at the office of the King County director of finance in Seattle, Washington, solely out of the Road Improvement District No. 91 Construction Fund. Reference is made to Ordinance No. 6503 and Motion No. of the county for the terms and conditions upon which this Warrant is issued.

It is hereby certified and declared that this Warrant is issued pursuant to and in strict compliance with the Constitution and laws of the State of Washington and ordinances of the county and that all acts, conditions and things required to have happened, been done and performed precedent to and in the issuance hereof have happened, been done and performed.

SECTION 6. The Warrant shall not be transferrable in part and shall be transferrable in whole only upon surrender of the Warrant and reissuance of a new warrant executed in the manner provided in Section 7 to the transferee.

SECTION 7. The proposal of Rainier National Bank, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, dated December 15, 1983, to purchase the Warrant on the terms and conditions stated therein and in this ordinance is hereby accepted. The Warrant shall be sold at the par value thereof, shall be executed by the King County executive and shall be attested by the clerk of the council.

SECTION 8. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for
