- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of alley in plat of Coalfield, hereinafter described.
- 2. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of Coalfield Addition recorded September 16, 1912. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area had ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is therefore classified "C" Class, in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of public works considers the remaining subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
