ORDINANCE NO. 6799

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Kirkland East Planning Area Comprehensive Sewer Plan

PREAMBLE:

On March 12, 1984, the City of Kirkland adopted a Declaration of Non-Significance for the City's Comprehensive Sewer Plan.

On March 19, 1984, the Kirkland City Council passed Ordinance No. 2796 adopting the Comprehensive Sewer Plan for the city.

On March 20, 1984 the City of Kirkland completed its submittal to King County of an adopted sewer plan pursuant to KCC Chapter 13.24.

As required by KCC 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) reviewed the proposed plan on April 3, 1984 and recommended its approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Kirkland East Planning Area Comprehensive Sewer Plan as adopted by City Ordinance No. 2796 is here by approved.
