AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended by reclassifying certain property upon the application of PHILIP H. JONES, JR., designated Building and Land Development File No. 209-84-R, and deleting and amending conditions.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the March 28, 1984 report of the zoning and subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on April 12, 1984 on the application of PHILIP H. JONES, JR. to reclassify certain property described in building and land development file no. 209-84-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation by the zoning and subdivision examiner to reclassify the subject property from SR (Potential RM 900) to RM 900-P subject to conditions is hereby adopted by the council of King County, with the following amendments to conditions:

Condition No. 1. Delete

Condition No. 2. Renumber as Condition 1.

Condition No. 3. Renumber as Condition 2.

Condition No. 4. Renumber as Condition 3.

Condition No. 5 is amended to read as renumbered Condition 4:

Development of the overall site shall be in conformance to the Federal Way Community Plan.

Condition No. 6. Renumber as Condition 5.

Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within one year of council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the
