STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Laurel Lane South, hereinafter described:
- 2. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County comprehensive plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of Dixon's Lake Park 2nd Addition recorded in Volume 26 of Plats, page 3, records of King County, Washington. In accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759, the vacation area is classified "B" Class. King County is now in receipt of \$229.17 from the petitioner which has been judged to be the just compensation to King County for this vacation area.
- 5. The department of public works considers the remaining subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
