AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, INC., designated Building and Land Development File No. 106-84-R.

SECTION 1.
