ORDINANCE NO. 6841

AN ORDINANCE relating to meetings of the King County Council and amending K.C.C. 1.24.020, and Ordinance No. 1373, Section 3.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. K.C.C. 1.24.020 and Ordinance 1373, Section 3 are hereby amended to read as follows:

The time of meeting of the council shall be at 9:30 a.m. on Monday of each week, unless otherwise ordered by the council.

All sessions of the county council, except as otherwise ordered by the council, and except meetings of committees, shall be held at the county seat. The proceedings of all council meetings shall be taken by tape recorder. The tapes of such meetings shall be retained in the office of the ((administrator)) clerk for a period of five years, at which time the tapes shall be transferred to the division of records and elections, which will retain such tapes for an additional five years.
