ORDINANCE NO. 6848

1 AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the  
2 Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County  
3 Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying  
4 certain property upon the application of PACIFIC  
BELLEVUE DEVELOPMENTS, designated Building and Land  
Development File No. 221-84-R.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY.

6 SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and  
7 conclusions of the June 8, 1984 report of the zoning and subdivision  
8 examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on June 28, 1984,  
9 on the application of Pacific Bellevue Developments to reclassify  
10 certain property described in building and land development file no. 221-84-R.

11 SECTION 2. The recommendation by the zoning and subdivision examiner to  
12 reclassify the subject property from SR (Potential RM 2400)  
13 to RM 2400-P subject to conditions is hereby adopted by  
14 the council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be satisfied  
15 before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within two years of  
16 council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and  
17 this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. (If none, the  
18 effective date shall be ten days after enactment.) Upon this ordinance  
19 becoming effective, the building and land development division shall amend the  
20 official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
