ORDINANCE NO. 6855

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date of an election on the question of annexation of the City of Lake Forest Park to King County Fire Protection District No. 16; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Lake Forest Park by Ordinance No. 297 has determined that it is in the public interest, health, safety and general welfare to provide for annexation to Fire District No. 16 in accordance with R.C.W. 52.04.170.

SECTION 2. Said Ordinance does satisfy the provisions of R.C.W. 52.04.170 for qualification for annexation.

SECTION 3. King County Fire Protection District No. 16, by Resolution No. 83-04, concurs in the annexation of the City of Lake Forest Park to the District in accordance with R.C.W. 52.04.170 through .190.

SECTION 4. The King County Boundary Review Board, by its decision dated January 17, 1984, approved the proposal as submitted, all in accordance with R.C.W. 36.93.100.

SECTION 5. A special election in accordance with R.C.W. 52.04.180 shall be held on the 18th day of September, 1984, or at the next special election date as provided by law, to be held in the City of Lake Forest Park and the King County Fire Protection District No. 16.

8 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary  
9 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety  
10 or for the support of county government and its existing public
