ORDINANCE NO. 6856

AN ORDINANCE granting Conditional Interim approval to the 1981 Water System Comprehensive Plan of the City of North Bend.

PREAMBLE:

On June 2, 1981, the City of North Bend adopted a Final Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed 1981 Water System Comprehensive Plan.

On April 2, 1982 the City of North Bend adopted the 1981 Water System Comprehensive Plan by City Council Motion.

On February 10, 1984, the City of North Bend completed its submittal to King County of an adopted Water Comprehensive Plan pursuant KCC Chapter 13.24.

As required by KCC 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) reviewed the proposed plan and on April 3, 1984 recommended a conditional interim approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The 1981 City of North Bend Water System

Comprehensive Plan as adopted by the City of North Bend is hereby granted interim approval for a period of one year to expire on April 3, 1985 subject to the following conditions:

A. Approval is granted only for the service area shown in the 1981 Water System Plan.

1 B. Connections may only be made to existing lots and plats
2 and short plats that have received preliminary approval prior to
3 April 3, 1984, that are adjacent to existing mains.
