AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of 201st Street V-1825 Petitioner: William O. and Gladys F. Jackson

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of South 201st Street, hereinafter described.
- 2. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of the Plat of the Southern Pacific Land Company's Huntington Park Addition to Des Moines as recorded October 25, 1889 in Volume 4 of Plats, page 24, Records of King County, Washington. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified Class "C". in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of public works considers the remaining subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 1646 day of ________, 1984 _____.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the 16th day of July 1984, hereby vacates and abandons the portion of South 201st Street, described as follows:

That portion of South 201st Street lying North of Lot 1, Block 77, Southern Pacific Land Company's Huntington Park Addition to Des Moines, according to the plat recorded in Volume 4 of plats, page 24, records of King County, Washington, and lying Southerly of that area as vacated by Superior Court action, Superior Court Cause No. 717091.
