STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of an alley in Plat of Fall City.
- 2. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of the Plat of Fall City filed July, 1887, as recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, page 80, records of King County, Washington. We found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of public works considers the remaining subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council, on the 16 th day of July 19 84, hereby vacates and abandons the portion of an alley in Plat of Fall City, described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 18; thence Westerly 20 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 13; thence Southerly along the Easterly margin of Lots 13, 14, and 15, to the Southeast corner of Lot 15; thence Easterly 20 feet to The Southwest corner of Lot 16;

thence Northerly along the Westerly margin of Lots 16, 17, and 18, to the Northwest corner of Lot 18 and the point beginning. All being in Block 5 Plat of Fall City as recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, page 80, records of King County, situate in the County of King, State of Washington. The vacation area contains approximately 2,800 square feet, or 0.0644 acres more or less.
