AN ORDINANCE relating to solid waste management; establishing a Solid Waste Advisory Committee.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Solid Waste Advisory Committee is hereby established to be comprised of a county-wide group of representatives of citizens, public interest groups, business, the waste management industry and local elected public officials to provide for coordination and information exchange between the groups about solid waste issues and to provide on-going public input and advice to King County on solid waste management issues.

SECTION 2. The King County Solid Waste Advisory Committee shall be composed of nine members representing a balance of interests among the groups listed in Section 1.

SECTION 3. The King County Solid Waste Advisory Committee shall advise and make recommendations to the county executive on matters within their scope and charge.

SECTION 4. The scope and charge of the King County Solid Waste Advisory Committee shall be to:

- A. advise King County on all aspects of solid waste management planning
- B. assist King County in the development of programs and polcies concerning solid waste management
- C. review and comment on proposed solid waste management rules, policies, or ordinances prior to their adoption.

SECTION 5. Regular members shall be appointed by the county executive subject to confirmation by county council motion. The executive shall be able to appoint non-voting ex-officio members who shall serve at the executive's discretion.

SECTION 6. Members may be reappointed to serve consecutive terms. Reappointment shall be subject to confirmation by county council motion.

SECTION 7. A vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of 1 the term of the vacant position in the manner described in the 2 initial appointment. 3 SECTION 8. Members shall serve a term of three (3) years or until their successor is appointed and confirmed as provided in 5 this ordinance. The terms of office shall be staggered 6 consistent with the provisions of Chapter 2.28 King County Code. 7 SECTION 9. A majority of the committee shall elect one of 8 its members as chair. The term of the chair shall be for one 9 10 year. SECTION 10. Ongoing administrative support to the committee 11 shall be provided by the solid waste division manager. 12 SECTION 11.
