

ORDINANCE NO. 6872

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$2,820,650 to Capital Improvement Project No. 046288, Newport Hills Mudslide, from future limited tax G.O. bond proceeds and the River and Flood Control Construction fund balance; for piping of the stream and stabilization of the ravine; and amending Ordinance No. 6597, Section 77, Attachment No. 1, as amended; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$2,820,650 to CIP Project No. 046288, Newport Hills Mudslide; \$2,250,200 from the River and Flood Control Construction fund balance and \$570,450 from future bond proceeds or other available revenues approved by the council.

Provided that:

Beginning September 1, 1984, the surface water management division manager shall provide monthly reports to the council on the progress of this project. These monthly reports shall include, but not be limited to description and listing of quantities and unit costs for materials and shall also include the costs for all county force activities.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 77, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be dispersed the following amounts for the specific projects identified and contained in Attachment No. 1 of this ordinance as adjusted to include the specific project amendments listed within this section.
