

ORDINANCE NO. 6874

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Standardized Salary
2 Schedule and the annual cost-of-living increase
3 for King County employees as stipulated in K.C.C.
4 3.12.130 and K.C.C. 3.12.140; amending Ordinance
5 6673, Section 5 to provide the department of
6 Public Safety police collective bargaining
7 settlement for Majors in the department of Public
8 Safety and the Corrections Officers collective
9 bargaining settlement for the Lieutenants in the
10 department of Adult Detention.

11 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

12 SECTION 1. Ordinance 6673, Section 5 is hereby amended to
13 read as follows:

14 Employees of the executive branch, non-elected employees of
15 the department of assessments, and employees of the alcoholism
16 and substance abuse, emergency medical services and medical
17 examiner divisions of the Seattle-King County department of
18 public health not included in collective bargaining units shall
19 have their salaries increased by one and one-half percent (1.5%)
20 effective January 1, 1984; except for employees holding the rank
21 of Captain and Major in the department of public safety, those
22 holding the rank of lieutenant in the department of adult
23 detention, those defined as first level supervisors in the
24 department of public works, and the airport security chief.
25 Captains and Majors in the department of public safety (~~and~~
26 ~~Lieutenants-in-the-department-of-adult-detention~~) shall have
27 their salaries increased by the percentage increase accorded the
28 police bargaining unit for 1984. Lieutenants in the department
29 of adult detention shall have their salaries increased by the
30 percentage increase accorded the Corrections Officer bargaining
31 unit for 1984. Assistant supervisors in the public works
32 department shall have their salaries increased by an amount
33 equivalent to that provided to equipment operator II positions
covered by the Construction Crafts agreement. The airport
security chief salary increase shall be that required to maintain

1 a 7.5% differential above the 1984 airport security officer II
2 annualized wage rate.
