ordinance no. 6875

AN ORDINANCE levying and setting the rate of an excise tax on the use of all telephone access lines in King County as approved by the voters of King County in November 1981 for the purpose of paying for the implementation and operation of an enhanced 911 emergency telephone system, providing for administration and collection of the tax consenting to the inspection of the tax, consenting to the inspection of records, and establishing the effective date of the tax.

PREAMBLE:

The people of King County in November 1981 authorized the imposition of an excise tax on telephone access lines to pay for implementation and operation of an enhanced 911 emergency telephone system. Pursuant to Ordinance 6507, King County has entered into an agreement with Pacific Northwest Bell telephone company for provision of such an emergency telephone system. The expected implementation date of that emergency services communication system is September 2, 1985.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied an excise tax on the use of all taxable telephone access lines in King County, as authorized by Laws of 1981, ch. 160, Sec. 3, and RCW 82.14B.030. and pursuant to Ordinance 5680 and the approval of the voters of King County in November 1981.

SECTION 2. The rate of the tax imposed by Section 1 shall be forty-five cents per month per telephone access line.

SECTION 3. The proceeds of the tax imposed by this ordinance and investment earnings therefrom shall be used only to pay for the implementation and operation of an enhanced 911 emergency telephone system.

SECTION 4. The executive shall administer and collect the tax consistent with procedures approved in Ordinance 6507. The tax imposed by this ordinance shall be collected from the user by the telephone company providing the access line, and the due date

1	for remittance of the tax collected shall be thirty days
2	following the collection month. Telephone companies collecting
3	the tax shall be reimbursed for the actual costs of

5	SECTION 5. The county hereby consents to the inspection of
6	such records as are necessary to qualify the county for
7	inspection of records of the Department of Revenue, pursuant to
8	RCW 82.32.330.
9	SECTION 6. The tax imposed by this ordinance shall be
10	effective from and after September 2, 1984.
11	SECTION 7. If any provision of this ordinance or its
12	application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the
13	remainder of this ordinance or the application of the provisions
