

ORDINANCE NO. 6881

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$67,000 from the solid waste operating fund balance to conduct additional testing of soil and water quality at the Cedar Hills Sanitary Landfill; and amending Ordinance No. 6597, Section 61, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$67,000 to solid waste operations, to conduct additional testing of soil and water quality at the Cedar Hills Sanitary Landfill.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 61, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Solid Waste Operating Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Solid Waste Operating ((~~\$47,292,004~~)) \$17,359,004

The maximum number of FTE's to be budgeted for the solid waste fund shall be: 164.50

Provided that:

1. No funds shall be expended on a Cedar Hills Site Development Plan prior to council approval of the scope, cost and schedule of this project.

2. The executive shall provide a revised estimate of the appropriate landfill replacement tonnage charges in the 1985 solid waste budget.

3. The funding requested as a local match for the Energy Resource Recovery Study is not adopted pending council approval of the Stage 1 Study and the scope of work for Stages 2 and 3.

4. The fourteen positions funded for six months will be reviewed subsequent to the publication of the auditor's Solid Waste Staff Utilization Audit and any new information presented.
