ORDINANCE NO. 6889

AN ORDINANCE relating to boating regulations prohibiting the use or operation of internal combustion engines on Lake Joy; adding a new section to K.C.C. 12.44.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is added to K.C.C. 12.44 a new section to read as follows:

Lake Joy Restriction. It is unlawful to use or operate any internal combustion engine on Lake Joy, legally defined as:

"All the waters of Lake Joy located in Section 26 and Section 35, Township 26 North, Range 7E, W.M., in King County, Washington;"

PROVIDED THAT:

Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent any public official or construction company from performing authorized duties. The department of public works shall have the responsibility of posting and maintaining appropriate signs.
