ORDINANCE NO. 6903

AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control prohibiting parking at all times on the north side of Northeast 195th Street from 136th Avenue Northeast west to the service driveway for the Woodinville High School, and on the south side of Northeast 195th Street from 136th Avenue Northeast west to 133rd Court Northeast; and amending King County Ordinance 5292, Schedule 14.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to traffic engineering studies, and as authorized by RCW 46.90, Schedule 14 of King County Ordinance 5292, which prohibits parking at all times along county roads, is amended to add the following location:

NORTHEAST 195TH STREET, on the north side, from 136th Avenue Northeast west to the service driveway for the Woodinville High School, and on

NORTHEAST 195TH STREET, on the south side, from 136th Avenue Northeast west to 133rd Court Northeast.

SECTION 2. Signs posted to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority.

SECTION 3. Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor, and the punishment shall be provided by the laws of the State of Washington.
