

ORDINANCE NO. 6908

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Earthworks, limiting  
2 the hours of parking and imposing other  
3 restrictions at the Earthworks, formerly known as  
Johnson's Pit and declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. No person shall park a vehicle between dusk to  
6 dawn at the Earthworks, formerly known as Johnson's Pit and  
7 described as follows:

8 Lot 9 Van Devanter's 10-Acre tracts, as per  
9 plat recorded in Volume 12 of Plats, page  
84, Records of King County, WA.

10 SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to consume  
11 alcoholic beverages within the Earthworks and its associated  
12 parking area.

13 SECTION 3. The dumping of refuse or littering on the site  
14 of Earthworks is prohibited.

15 SECTION 4. The starting of fires for any purpose on the  
16 site of the Earthworks is prohibited.

17 SECTION 5. Motorized vehicles shall not be permitted on the  
18 Earthworks and shall be parked only within the designated  
19 parking areas.

20 SECTION 6. The King County executive is hereby directed and  
21 authorized to 1) post the property and 2) take appropriate  
22 action to enforce the restrictions identified in Sections 1  
23 through 5 of this ordinance.

24 SECTION 7. Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor  
25 and is punishable, upon conviction by a fine not exceeding  
26 \$250.00 or by confinement in the County jail for a period not  
27


1 exceeding 90 days or both.

2 SECTION 8. The county council finds as a fact and declares  
3 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary  
4 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety  
5 or for the support of county government and its existing public  
6 institutions.




