ORDINANCE NO. 6909

AN ORDINANCE relating to boating regulations;  
prohibiting the use or operation of internal  
combustion engines on Lake Walker; adding a  
new section to K.C.C. 12.44

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is added to K.C.C. 12.44 a new section to  
read as follows:

Lake Walker Restriction. It is unlawful to use or operate  
any internal combustion engine on Lake Walker, legally defined as:

"All the water of Lake Walker located in the Western half of  
Section 34, Township 21 North, Range 7E, W.M., in King  
County, Washington;"

PROVIDED THAT:

Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent any  
public official or construction company from performing  
authorized duties. The department of public works shall have  
the responsibility of posting and maintaining appropriate signs.

June, 1984.
