## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of the Plat of Shep's Olympic View Addition (drainage easement), hereinafter described.
- 2. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed drainage easement vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The division of surface water management has reviewed the proposed drainage easement vacation and have made the following recommendations as conditions of approval:
  - a. Vacate the westerly five feet of the ten-foot easement only.
  - b. The retaining wall can be constructed on the easement.
  - c. The owner of Lot 3 is responsible for all maintenance of the easement and improvements.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of Shep's Olympic View Addition as recorded in Volume 114 of Plats, page 45. No evidence was found that the vacation area has ever been open and used for drainage. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The easement is, therefore classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The department of public works considers the described subject easement usless as part of the county drainage system and believes the public would be benefited by the removal of the encumbrance.
