

ORDINANCE NO. 6945

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$1,119,941 to CIP Project No. 030074, Cougar Mountain Regional Wildland Park; from undesignated 1984 proceeds of the Conservation Futures Tax and from proceeds of a future Bond Anticipation Note; directing the director of the office of finance to prepare legislation authorizing the issuance of a Bond Anticipation Note; authorizing interim financing; and amending Ordinance No. 6597, Section 77, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$1,119,941 to CIP Project No. 030074, Cougar Mountain Regional Wildland Park; \$499,941 from undesignated 1984 proceeds of the Conservation Futures Tax and \$620,000 from proceeds of a future Bond Anticipation Note or from other monies legally available for such purpose, for the purpose of property acquisition for Cougar Mountain Park.

SECTION 2: Ordinance No. 6597, Section 77, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be dispersed the following amounts for the specific projects identified and contained in Attachment No. 1 of this ordinance as adjusted to include the specific project amendments listed within this section.

SECTION 3: The director of the office of finance is hereby directed to prepare legislation authorizing the issuance of a Bond Anticipation Note in the amount of \$620,000 for the purpose of providing funds for 1984 property acquisition for Cougar Mountain Park.

SECTION 4: The executive is hereby authorized to seek and execute agreements to provide interim financing for this appropriation; to cover cash shortfalls which may otherwise occur before full collection of 1984 tax proceeds or issuance of a Bond Anticipation Note referenced in Section 3, or both.

SECTION 5: The project information sheet attached hereto is adopted to amend and revise the 1984 Capital Improvement Program and Budget, Ordinance No. 6597, Section 77, Attachment No. 1, as amended.
