AN ORDINANCE vacating a portion of August Nordin Road No. 503 - V-1783 Petitioner: Rodger Scott and Others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of August Nordin Road No. 503 hereinafter described.
- 2. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed road vacation.
- 3. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 4. The department of planning and community development recommends approval of the road vacation on condition that the petitioner dedicates 15 feet of additional right-of-way along Kent-Kangley Road and provides adequate setback along the stream corridor for future improvements. King County is now in receipt of a Warranty Deed signed by Rodger C. and Stella Scott, Anton D. and Leanne Sorensen, and Paula L. and Ed Day, for the required 15 feet of right-of-way.
- 5. The vacation area is a portion of August Nordin Road, County Road No. 503, established July 22, 1899. No evidence was found that the vacation area had ever been open as a public road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement, or maintenance. The road is therefore classified "C" Class in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 6. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the day of Cross , 1984
