ORDINANCE NO. 6981

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve subject to conditions (modified), the preliminary plat of NORWAY MEADOWS, designated Building and Land Development File No. 284-6, and adding additional findings, conclusions and conditions.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the reports of the zoning and subdivision examiner dated June 18, 1984 and August 24, 1984 which were filed with the clerk of the council on September 13, 1984, to approve subject to conditions (modified) the preliminary plat of NORWAY MEADOWS, designated by the building and land development division, department of planning and community development, file no. 284-6, and the council does adopt as its action the recommendation(s) contained in said reports, together with the following additional findings, conclusions and conditions.

FINDINGS.

- 1. The appellant Quam resides in a home served by an on-site sewage disposal system. It is his concern that the drainfield of that system may extend across his property line into the applicant's (respondent) ownership. In the event that development on the respondent's property should have an adverse impact on his drainfield, Mr. Quam is desirous of having the ability to connect to sewer lines installed for the plat of Norway Meadows.
- 2. Appellant Aagaard has requested that the applicant be required to place paved shoulders along 112th Ave. N.E. on those portions of its property which are adjacent to that roadway. Paved shoulders are currently in place to the north of the subject site. However, no shoulders currently exist to the south nor adjacent to those properties along 112th Ave. N.E. which are surrounded by the subject subdivision. Appellant's lot no. 2 at the northerly

entrance to the proposed subdivision has 60 feet of frontage on 112th Ave. N.E.

3. Under the configuration recommended for approval by the hearing examiner, lot no. 7 of the subdivision of Norway Meadows would enjoy direct access onto 112th Ave. N.E. No other plats recently approved in the neighborhood enjoy such a direct access onto that roadway. The four lots immediately north of the lot in question do directly access onto 112th Ave. N.E.

CONCLUSIONS:

- 1. It is concluded that Milton Quam should have an easement that would permit him to connect to the sewer system proposed for the subdivision of Norway Meadows in the event that development of the subject subdivision should interfere with his existing on-site sewage disposal system. Therefore, the recommended conditions will be amended to reflect this conclusion.
- 2. It is concluded that pedestrian safety and school bus parking would be enhanced by the provision of a paved shoulder along those portions of proposed lot no. 2 which are adjacent to 112th Ave. N.E. Therefore, the condition should be amended to require the applicant to provide a paved shoulder along that portion of the plat.
- 3. It is concluded that there should be no direct access onto 112th Ave. N.E. from lot no. 7 of the proposed subdivision insofar as it would be inconsistent with the community plan which calls for preserving the rural character of that roadway. In order to accomplish this end,

provide alternate access to lot no. 7 of the proposed subdivision of Norway Meadows. 3 4. A substitute ordinance shall be prepared to amend the conditions for preliminary approval of the plat of Norway Meadows in accordance with the conclusions above. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS.
