1 AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$11,750 to the Solid
2 Waste Division for Transfer Station Chute
3 Modifications and the waste reduction and
4 recycling programs; and amending Ordinance 6597,
Sections 61 and 77, as amended.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a
7 supplemental appropriation of \$4,447 from the solid waste
8 operating fund balance for the purpose of developing King County
9 waste reduction and recycling programs.

10 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 61, as amended, is
11 hereby amended to read as follows:

12 From the Solid Waste Operating Fund there is hereby
13 appropriated to:

15 SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted a
16 supplemental appropriation of \$7,303 to C.I.P. Project No.
17 003075, Transfer Station Chute Modification, from the Solid Waste
18 Construction Fund-1981 fund balance; for the purpose of meeting
19 final construction costs.

20 SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 6597, Section 77, as amended, is
21 hereby amended to read as follows:

23 hereby appropriated and authorized to be dispersed the following
