AN ORDINANCE relating to road vacation; establishing classes of roads and compensation which may be required for vacation; and amending Ordinance 2759, Section 2 and K.C.C. 14.40.020B.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2759, Section 2, and K.C.C. 14.40.020 is hereby amended as follows:

Amount. The amount of compensation, if required in this chapter, shall be determined by the council according to the following criteria:

A. Vacation of all county roads included in Classes A and B, if granted, shall require compensation at the full appraised value of the vacated road as of the effective date of the vacation, which amount, for the purposes of this chapter, may be determined from the records of the department of assessments; provided, that the council shall have authority to accept real property of equal value in lieu of cash compensation where the value of the road to be vacated is not more than the value of the real property to be acquire by such exchange.

B. Vacation of all county roads included in Class C and Class D, if granted, ((may)) require a two hundred dollar fee as compensation ((based on)) for the administrative costs of the vacation.

C. When a road is vacated for a governmental agency, compensation may be based on the administrative costs of the vacation or may, in the discretion of the council, be based on original cost of acquisition.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1985.
