BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5783 as amended and K.C.C.

7.08.010 are amended to read as follows:

GENERALLY. All persons using King County owned and operated park and recreation facilities shall pay the service fees, which include taxes, where applicable, set forth in the following schedules in this chapter, effective January 1, ((1984)) 1985.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 5783, as amended, and K.C.C.
7.08.040 are amended to read as follows:
