ORDINANCE NO. 7025

An ordinance establishing fees for the King County department of public works, roads and engineering division's review and inspection of applications, permits, improvement plans and profiles, and recording maps for building permits, right of way construction and use permits, special use permits, planned unit developments, subdivisions, short subdivisions and residential condominium binding site plans; amending Ordinance 1711, Section 4 and KCC 14.44.040, Ordinance 6257, Section 3 and KCC 16.86.010, Ordinance 6465, Section 10 and KCC 19.34.080, and Ordinance 2534, Section 1 and KCC 21.62.050; adding a new section to KCC Title 16, adding new sections to KCC Chapters 14.28, 14.30, 14.44, 16.86, 19.26, 19.28, 19.32, 19.34, 21.62.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is added a new section to KCC Title 16 to read as follows:

"Site Improvement Bond" refers to the bond or other approved security required by the department of public works as security for the applicant's guarantee of the construction, according to approved plans and County specifications, of roadway and right-of-way improvements, traffic requirements, appurtenances, off-street parking, curbing, drainage, retention/detention facilities, and erosion/sedimentation control associated with commercial building permits.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 1711, Section 4, and KCC 14.44.040 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

Construction permit - Application - Fees. A. Each application requires a fee payable to the real property division for the administrative costs and expenses of processing the application. The following fee schedule shall become effective as of January 1, 1981:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 5. There is added a new section to KCC 14.30 to read as follows:

The permit applicant is required to pay an inspection fee at the rate of forty dollars per hour to the department of public works, roads and engineering division, for inspections necessary to establish compliance with the terms and conditions of each special use permit. The fees are in addition to any other county fees and are nonrefundable. The fees shall be collected in accordance with administrative procedures developed by the department of public works.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 6. There is added a new section to KCC 16.86 to read as follows:

- A. The department of public works, roads and engineering division, shall be compensated for review of improvement plans for commercial building permits and for inspection of roads, sidewalks, curbing, curbs and gutters, paving, parking areas outside of buildings, drainage, erosion and sedimentation control associated with commercial building permits.
- B. The following fees are in addition to any other county fees and are nonrefundable. Plan review fees shall be paid when plans are submitted for review. All outstanding construction inspection fees shall be paid prior to receiving final construction approval from the department of public works. The fees shall be collected in accordance with administrative procedures developed by the department of public works.

- a. The initial fee shall cover public works inspections for the first twelve months from the date of permit issuance. The annual fee shall be due and payable on each anniversary date of the permit issuance for each additional year or portion thereof until approval of construction and also, if applicable, final approval for recommended maintenance bond release by the department of

public works. The fees per building permit shall not exceed \$3,240 for initial fee and \$1,080 for annual fee.

- b. Valid permits which are charged an hourly rate and for which final construction approval has not been granted on or before December 31, 1984 shall be subject to the annual fee. The permitee shall pay a pro rata share of the annual fee to cover the cost of inspections between January 1, 1985 and the subject permit's anniversary date.
 - 3. Maintenance bond inspection fee \$320/b ond
 - 4. Defect bond inspection fee \$250/facility
 - 5. Code enforcement inspection fee \$40/hour
- C. All overdue construction inspection and code enforcement inspection fees are subject to late payment charges. Balances more than sixty days overdue from date of billing are subject to an additional charge of ten percent of the outstanding balance. Additional late charges will be assessed at a rate of one percent per month on the outstanding fee balance due, exclusive of accumulating late charges.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 7. There is added a new section to KCC 19.26 to read as follows:

- A. The department of public works, roads and engineering division, shall be compensated for review of short subdivisions including final short plats and improvement plans and profiles, and for inspection of roads, sidewalks, curbing, curbs and gutters, paving, parking areas outside of buildings, drainage, erosion and sedimentation control associated with short subdivisions.
- B. The following fees are in addition to any other county fees and are nonrefundable. Plan review fees shall be paid when plans are submitted for review. All outstanding construction inspection fees shall be paid prior to receiving final construction approval from the department of public works. The fees shall be collected in accordance with administrative procedures developed by the department of public works.

- a. The initial fee shall cover public works inspections for the first twelve months from the date of approval of required improvement plans, or from the date of preliminary plat approval, if improvement plans were not required. The annual fee shall be due and payable on each anniversary date of required improvement plans approval or of preliminary plat approval, if improvement plans were not required; for each additional year or portion thereof until approved by the department of public works.
- b. Short subdivisions which are charged an hourly rate and for which final construction approval has not been granted on or before December 31, 1984 shall be subject to the annual fee. The subdivider shall pay a pro rata share of the annual fee to cover the cost of inspections between January 1, 1985 and the anniversary date for annual fee payment.
- c. Short plats requiring only a twelve foot driveable surface pursuant to KCC 19.26.270C1 shall pay a one hundred dollar per year inspection fee.

- C. All overdue construction inspection and code enforcement inspection fees are subject to late payment charges. Additional late charges will be assessed at a rate of one percent per month on the outstanding fee balance due, exclusive of accumulating late charges.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 8. There is added a new section to KCC 19.28 to read as follows:

The department of public works, roads and engineering division, shall be
compensated for reviewing preliminary plat applications. The following fees
are in addition to any other county fees and are non-refundable. Fees shall be
paid when applications are submitted for review. The following fees shall be
collected in accordance with administrative procedures developed by the
department of public works:
