AN ORDINANCE approving the Water District 90
Plan Amendment (ULID 7)

PREAMBLE:

On March 20, 1984, Water District 90 passed Resolution 414,
Amending their Comprehensive Plan.

On May 15, 1984, Water District 90 passed Resolution 414
determining that the proposed amendment was categorically
exempt from the State Environmental Policy Act.

On September 6, 1984, Water District 90 completed their
submittal to King County pursuant to RCW 57.16 and KCC
13.24.

On September 18, 1984, as required by King County Code
13.24 the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the
proposed plan and recommended approval based on the
following findings:

1. Water sources in the area have become contaminated
2. 51% of the owners of the property have requested
to form a ULID; and
3. Water District 90 should extend water service.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 90 Comprehensive Plan
Amendment (ULID 7) is hereby approved.
