ORDINANCE NO. 7034

AN ORDINANCE approving Water District 90's  
Comprehensive Plan

PREAMBLE:

On September 4, 1984, Water District 90 passed Resolution 437, adopting the Comprehensive Plan.

On September 4, 1984, Water District 90 passed Resolution 436, adopting Declaration of Non-Significance for the proposed plan.

On September 14, 1984, Water District 90 completed their submittal to King County pursuant to RCW 57.16 and KCC 13.24.

On October 2, 1984, as required by King County Code 13.24, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed plan and recommended approval, with the qualification that the area within the Tahoma/Raven Heights Community Plan not be approved at this time.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Water District 90 Comprehensive Plan is hereby approved, PROVIDED, the area falling within the Tahoma/Raven Heights Community Plan is not approved at this time.
