- 4. The vacation area was quit claimed to King County April 26, 1969 and recorded in Auditor's File No. 6518983. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance.
