

1 Provided that:

2 Included in special programs is an executive contingency
3 of ((~~\$225,564~~) \$122,364) which shall not be expended unless the
4 county executive certifies in writing that funds are available
5 and requests the county council adopt an additional
6 appropriation ordinance; upon adoption, such funds may be
7 expended for the purpose specified.

8 1. Up to \$239,676 is reserved in the executive
9 contingency for 18.8 positions (9.4 FTE's) to staff one
10 residential floor in the new jail, should inmate population
11 levels require its use.

12 2. \$10,000 shall be used as a reward for information
13 leading to the identification and prosecution of the Green
14 River murderer.

15 3. Alcoholism. \$181,042 shall be held in executive
16 contingency in special programs pending the development of a
17 revised division budget.
