ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 3689, Section 2, and concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to grant approval of a shoreline environment redesignation, petitioned by King County Parks and Recreation Division, designated Building and Land Development File No. 058-83-SD.
