ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_7031

AN ORDINANCE creating King County Road Improvement District No. 95 for the improvement of a portion of Southwest 171st Street.

PREAMBLE:
Pursuant to King County Motion No. 6150, a public hearing was held on gammany 7, 1985, on the petitions of property owners within the proposed district for the formation of a road improvement district to improve certain streets.

Notice of said hearing was duly published and was duly mailed to each property owner pursuant to the requirements of RCW 36.88.050. A diagram showing the lots specially benefited by the Project and the estimated cost and expense to be borne by each lot or building site was considered by the Council.

All written and verbal protests were considered. It is hereby found that the said petitions, including all additions thereto and withdrawals therefrom made prior to 5 o'clock p.m. of the business day before the hearing, are sufficient. It is further found that all requirements of RCW 36.88.020, 36.88.060, 36.88.410, and King County Motion No. 6150 have been satisfied.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: There is hereby established, pursuant to Chapter 36.88 RCW, a road improvement district in King County to be known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 95" (hereinafter "RID 95"). Said District shall include all the territory described as follows:

Within the plat of Gregory Heights Division No. 2 in Southwest quarter, Section 25, Township 23 North, Range 3 East, W.M., beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 13, Block 11, thence N 03° 32' 05" E, 191.84 feet, thence N 86° 27' 55" W 150 feet, thence S 03° 32' 05" W 65.00 feet, thence perpendicular along a line to a point on the Westerly line of Lot 16, Block 11. thence S 06° 52' 00" W to the Northwest corner Lot 26, Block 11, thence S 80° 01' 30" E 225.33 feet, thence S 48° 12' 50" E 91.46 feet, thence S 06° 52' 00" W 143.93 feet, thence along a curve to the right having a radius of 30.00 feet through a central angle of 73° 58' 08", an arc distance of 38.73 feet to the most Northerly corner of Lot 19, Block 15, thence S 73° 02' 45" E 44.77 feet, thence N 87° 02' 45" E 24.43 feet, thence S 06° 52' 00" W 214.45 feet to the Southeast corner of said Lot 19, thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 320.39 feet through a central angle of 22° 17' 28", an arc distance of 124.65 feet, thence N  $74^{\circ}$ 04' 05" W 631.36 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 10, Block 15, thence N 03° 32' 05" E 343 feet more or less to the Southwest corner of Lot 11,

Block 11, thence along the margin of right of way S 83° 37' 30" E 99.52 feet, thence S  $60^{\circ}$  14' 30" E 56.43 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: The following described street, which is wholly within RID 95, shall be improved by clearing, grubbing, grading, draining, ballasting, paving, sidewalks, curbs and gutters, overhead utility undergrounding, erosion control, necessary affected off-site drainage, and such other work as may be incidental thereto, in accordance with the request on the petition (which improvements are hereinbefore and hereinafter referred to as the "Project"):

Southwest 171st Street from approximately 31st Avenue SW to approximately 28th Avenue SW a distance of 650 feet more or less.

SECTION 3: The costs and expenses of accomplishing the project are now estimated to be \$382,420.00. Adverse soils conditions may dictate an increase in costs.

The costs and expenses of work to be done within the right-of-way will be borne by and assessed against the property within the boundary of RID 95. The final amount of said costs and expense will be determined after the project has been completed.

It is further the intention of the council that the property owners' share of the costs and expenses shall be assessed against each buildable lot within the assessment boundary of RID 95.

The final amount of the assessment against each parcel of property within RID 95 shall be dependent upon the final total of such costs and expenses incurred in accomplishing the project and shall, upon confirmation of the assessment roll by the council, become a lien against each such parcel of land within RID 95. Such assessments may be paid in full thereafter or at the option of the owner thereof, in twenty equal, annual and consecutive installments, together with interest on the diminishing principal at a rate which is one-half (1/2) of one percent (1%) higher than the net effective interest rate on the bonds, which will be sold to pay the cost of the improvements within RID 95 per annum plus a penalty of ten percent on the principal amount of any delinquent installment plus ten percent of all the then

penalty, shall, upon confirmation of the assessment roll by the Council, become a lien upon each lot or building site within RID 95 from the time said assessment roll is placed in the hands of the office of finance for collection.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found that the plan for improvement or construction in PID 95 is feasible and that the benefits to be derived therefrom by the

accrued and unpaid interest on the principal balance of the assessment. The

amount of the final assessment, together with interest and provisions for

tion in RID 95 is feasible and that the benefits to be derived therefrom by the property within said district, together with the amount of any King County road fund participation, exceed the cost and expense of the formation of said district and the contemplated construction or improvement therein.

SECTION 5: The director of the department of public works is hereby authorized and directed to contract with the necessary parties for the design and construction of the project. When the project has been completed and all the costs and expenses are known or can be predicted with reasonable accuracy, said director is further authorized and directed to prepare and file with the clerk of the King County council a final assessment roll setting forth that portion of the total costs and expenses of the project to be assessed against all the property within RID 95 and the amount to be assessed against each lot or building site.

SECTION 6: There is hereby created on the books of the King County office of finance two funds of the County, to be designated as the "King County Road Improvement District No. 95 Construction Fund" and the "King County Road Improvement District No. 95 Bond Fund," respectively.

All moneys collected by the office of finance upon any assessment levied on property within RID 95 for the accomplishment of the Project shall be placed in the said construction fund during the thirty-day period allowed for payment of such assessment without penalty or interest, and shall be placed in the said bond fund thereafter. Moneys in said funds shall be used for no other purpose than the payment of costs and expenses of accomplishing the project and the payment of the principal of or interest on warrants drawn upon or bonds issued against said funds.

SECTION 7: The office of finance, accounting section, is hereby authorized and directed to issue interest-bearing warrants against the King County Road

accomplishing the project.

Improvement District No. 95 construction fund to pay costs and expenses of accomplishing the project pending the redemption of said warrants with bonds issued for such purpose, as specified in RCW 36.88.330. Said warrants shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding the maximum allowable rate as shall be determined by said office of finance.

Following confirmation of the assessment roll by the council and expiration of the thirty-day period for payment of assessments without penalty or interest, the council will authorize the issuance of bonds sufficient in amount to redeem all the then outstanding warrants drawn against the RID 95

construction fund and to pay all other unpaid costs and expenses of

SECTION 8: "Costs and expenses of accomplishing the project," as used herein and in any subsequent ordinance relating to RID 95, shall mean those costs and expenses described in RCW 36.88.300, as follows: (1) The cost of all of the construction or improvement authorized in RID 95, including that portion of the construction or improvement within the limits of any street or road intersection, space, or spaces; (2) the estimated costs and expenses of all engineering and surveying necessary to be done by the county engineer or under his direction or by such other engineer as may be employed by the County Council; (3) the cost of all advertising, mailing, and publishing of all notices; and (4) the cost of legal service and any other expenses incurred by King County for RID 95 or in the formation thereof, or by said district in connection with such construction of improvement and in the financing thereof, including the issuance of bonds.
