ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve, subject to conditions (modified) the Preliminary Plat of EASTBROOK, designated File No. 884-4, and amending, adding and deleting conditions.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

This ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the zoning and subdivision examiner dated September 19, 1984 which was filed with the clerk of the council on October 4, 1984, to approve, subject to conditions (modified) the preliminary plat of EASTBROOK, designated by the building and land development division, department of planning and community development, file no. 884-4, and the council does hereby adopt as its action the recommendation contained in said report, with the following amendments:

Delete recommended conditions 13, 14 and 19.

Amend recommended condition 18 to read:

18. The easterly 30 feet of 176th Ave. N.E. adjacent to 1ot 39, together with a portion of the northwest corner of 1ot 39 and the southwest corner of 1ot 38 sufficient for a 50 foot radius turnaround, and a triangular tract south of 1ot 1 and adjacent to N.E. 153rd St./176th Ave. N.E. (as depicted in the illustrations displayed at the council meeting of January 7, 1985), shall be dedicated to King County. A temporary turnaround shall be constructed in the vicinity of the border between 1ots 38 and 39. Construction details shall be worked out with the Department of Public Works.
