- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 3. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed road vacation.
- N.E. Woodinville-Duvall Road is classified as a major arterial roadway and as such requires 50 feet of right of way on each side of the centerline. The vacation area lies outside the required 100-foot corridor for this roadway. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls. In accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759, the vacation area is classified Class "B." The petitioner has proposed an exchange of deeds with King county for needed right of way for the proposed N.E. 195th Street Extension Project. King county is now in receipt of a check for \$14,404.25 from the petitioner, which has been judged to be the just compensation to King county for this vacation area, and a Quit Claim Deed for 5,298 square feet of land for the proposed N.E. 195th Street Extension Project, which is a condition for the proposed road vacation, is in the process of being secured.
