## ordinance no. 7124

AN ORDINANCE relating to fees charged for the use of King County parks and recreation facilities; and amending Ordinance Nos. 5783, 6027, 6247, 6601, and 7015, and K.C.C. 7.08.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5783 as amended and K.C.C.

7.08.040 are amended to read as follows:

Recreation services. Recreation services fees shall be:

A. Fee structured program

Class fees. . . . . . Range \$5.00 to \$50.00 per class.

A ten percent administrative surcharge not to exceed \$5.00 will be assessed per participant per registration on the class or event cost for all fee structured classes, special events, athletic fee programs, workshops, special events or seminars. This administrative cost will not be charged for regularly scheduled programs or events which are intended solely for the enjoyment of citizens 55 years or older.

B. Entry and tournament fees (Leagues, tournament and special events fees to include officials, awards, sports equipment, administration fees and association fees.)

Adult Men's/Women's Leagues. . .\$100-\$600 per team/

Adult Men's/Women's Tournaments.\$50-\$200 per team/

Individual dual sports events. .\$5-\$50 per participant
