ORDINANCE NO. 7144

AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control, prohibiting loads in excess of 10,000 pounds except for local deliveries in King County on South 373rd Street, South 375th Street, 8th Avenue South and South 373rd Place (amending K.C.C. 46.44.080) and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. K.C.C. 46.44.080, prohibiting operation of trucks and other vehicles on county roads is hereby amended by adding the following:

SOUTH 373RD STREET (Pacific Highway South to South 372nd Way) 10,000 pounds

SOUTH 373RD STREET (8th Avenue South to South 372nd Way) 10,000 pounds

8TH AVENUE SOUTH (South 373rd Street to South 375th Street) 10,000 pounds

SOUTH 375TH STREET (8th Avenue South to Milton Road) 10,000 pounds

(except local deliveries in King County, school buses and emergency vehicles).

SECTION 2. Signs to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority and shall read, "Load Limit 5 Tons".

SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
