ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Board
2 of Appeals and Equalization and
3 establishing policy concerning
4 compensation of hearing examiners
5 employed by the Board and amending
6 Ordinance No. 6444, Section 5 and
7 K.C.C. 2.34.050.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 Section 1. Ordinance No. 6444, Section 5 and K.C.C.
10 2.34.050 are each amended to read as follows:

11 A. For time devoted to the official work of the board, each
12 member thereof shall receive a per diem allowance of seventy-five
13 dollars; provided, that a per diem allowance of thirty-five
14 dollars shall be paid for official board work of four hours or
15 less. Effective January 1, 1984, the per diem allowance shall
16 be increased to one hundred dollars except that a per diem
17 allowance of sixty dollars shall be paid for official board work
18 of four hours or less.

19 B. For time devoted to the official work of the board, each
20 hearing examiner employed by the board shall receive a per diem
21 allowance of ~~((seventy))~~ ninety dollars effective January 1,
22 1985; provided, that a per diem allowance of ~~((forty-two))~~
23 fifty-four dollars shall be paid for official examiner work of
24 four hours or less.

25 C. For time devoted to the official work of the board in
26 cases where due to a change of venue, the appeal is heard by the
27 members of a board of equalization of another county (the
28 receiving county) as provided for in K.C.C. 2.34.020, each
29 member of the board hearing the appeal shall receive the normal
30 per diem allowance authorized by ordinance enacted by the
31 legislative authority of the receiving county and a travel
32 allowance based on mileage from the receiving county seat to the
33 granting county seat, not to exceed mileage rates authorized
within the state by general law.

1 D. Members of the board assigned parking stalls shall pay
2 parking fees as provided for in K.C.C. 3.32 unless exempted
3 from payment by ordinance.
