## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Bruce S. Phillip road, hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works requests the vacation of a right-of-way granted by quit claim deed under King County Auditor's File No. 2767486 and recorded in Volume 1547 of Deeds, page 581, records of King County, Washington.
- 3. The department of public works requests this vacation on behalf of the State of Washington Department of Natural Resources. The State of Washington owns all lands on both sides of the proposed vacation area.
- 4. King County will receive, in exchange for the granting of the vacation, right-of-way for Southeast 72nd Place which is maintained by the department of public works. King County presently has no right-of-way for Southeast 72nd Place. The exchange of right-of-way will be mutually beneficial to the agencies involved. The vacation area contains 180,000 square feet more or less.
- 5. The various utilities serving the area have been notifed and the department of public works was advised that easements are not required.
- 6. The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 7. The vacation area has never been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is therefore classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 8. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system.
