

ORDINANCE NO. 7170

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the Recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, amending King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property upon the application of MARY N. CRENSHAW, designated Building and Land Development File No. 204-85-R.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the February 6, 1985 report of the zoning and subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on March 21, 1985, on the application of Mary N. Crenshaw to reclassify certain property described in the building and land development file no. 204-85-R.

SECTION 2. The recommendation of the zoning and subdivision examiner to reclassify the subject property from RD 3600 (Potential RM 2400) to RM 2400-P is hereby adopted by the council of King County. Those conditions, if any, which must be met before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied on or before February 1, 1986, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. The council may extend this date my motion pursuant to KCC 20.24.230. Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the building and land development division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
