

ORDINANCE NO. 7181

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of 105th Place Southeast and Southeast 180th Street (Carr Road to State Route 515)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1: The director of the department of public works has made an examination of 105th Place Southeast and Southeast 180th Street (Carr Road to State Route 515) along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

Section 2: Said road shall be established not less than 60 feet in width having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:  
Beginning at a point on the centerline of Carr Road as surveyed by King County Survey 31-23-5-5 and designated as Engineer's Station 53+04.68; thence S 01° 20' 08" West a distance of 1165.19 feet; thence along a tangent curve to the left having a radius of 75.00 feet through a central angle of 93° 09' 44" an arc distance of 121.95 feet; thence N 88° 10' 24' East a distance of 522.64 feet to the terminus, said terminus being S 01° 26' 23" West a distance of 1378.82 feet; thence S 88° 10' 24" West a distance of 220.36 feet from the North quarter corner of Section 32, Township 23 North, Range 5 East, W.M. King County, Washington.

1,809.78 lineal feet - 0.343 mile

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SECTION 3: King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
