AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as "First Avenue South and South 356th Street" to Lakehaven Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as "First Avenue South and South 356th Street" to Lakehaven Sewer District was filed with the county council effective April 5, 1985.
- 2. Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 84-1003 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Lakehaven Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated November 11, 1984 on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The county council held a public hearing on the $\underline{13th}$ day of \underline{MAY} , 19 $\underline{85}$ and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as "First Avenue South and South 356th Street" and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 56.02.060 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on "First Avenue South and South 356th Street".

SECTION 2. The Lakehaven Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, franchises, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area, nor does it authorize sewer service in any area not designated as a "Local Service Area" by the King County Sewerage General Plan.

SECTION 4. The area known as "First Avenue South and South 356th Street" to be annexed is described as follows:

The E 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., King County, Washington;

Together with that portion of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M. lying Southerly of the centerline of Libo Road (Southwest 356th Street).

Together with that portion of the E 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M. lying Southerly of the North right-of-way line of Libo Road (Southwest 356th Street).

Together with the S 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M.;

Together with the W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M., lying Westerly of the Westerly right-of-way of Pacific Highway South;

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a Portion of County Road No. 180 Petitioner: Robert J. Thompson and Others V-1869

A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of County Road No. 180, hereinafter described.

ORDINANCE NO.

- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that an easement was acquired by Puget Power.
- The division of building and land development has studied the subject proposed vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed road vacation.
- The vacation area is a portion of County Road No. 180 established in 1886. Research of this matter indicates that the vacation area has been open as a road, but no evidence was found that public funds had been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- The petition for this action contains ten freeholder signatures as required by RCW 36.87. King County policy requires approval of all adjacent or abutting owners whose property may be affected by this proposed road vacation. The petition fails to provide the signature for tax lot 24 (Gretchen Vaques) which abuts the proposed vacation area. The petitioner has explained the absence of this signature in a letter dated November 15, 1984 (copy enclosed).
- 236th Avenue Northeast is classified as a secondary arterial and as such should have 42 feet of right of way on each side of its centerline. Presently, there is only 30 feet of right of way on each side of the centerline of 236th Avenue Northeast. To deem this action mutually beneficial, tax lot 22 must deed 12 additional feet of right of way to King County in exchange for approval of its share of the vacation area. King County is now in receipt of a deed for the required 12 additional feet of right of way. The easterly segment of the vacation area was deleted at the request of the Washington State Department of Transportation.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the 1946 _____, 19<u>85____</u>. august

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
