ORDINANCE NO. 7254

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation, zoning and assumption of indebtedness to the City of Bellevue of unincorporated territory contiguous thereto commonly known as Ardmore East/Evergreen Highlands.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Bellevue, by Resolution 4536 has resolved that the best interests and general welfare of the City of Bellevue would be served by the annexation of contiguous unincorporated territory, commonly referred to as Ardmore East/Evergreen Highlands, and hereinafter described.

SECTION 2. Said Resolution does satisfy the provisions of RCW 35A.14.015 requesting the call for an election to be held to submit to the voters of such territory the proposal for annexation.

SECTION 3. A special election shall be held on the 17th day of September, 1985, within the territory of the proposed annexation, as hereinafter described, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors within the said territory the proposition of annexation, zoning and assumption of indebtedness to the City of Bellevue.

SECTION 4. The boundaries of the territory proposed for annexation are hereby described as follows:

The portion of the East half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 25 North, Range 5 E., W.M., lying Southeasterly of Bellevue-Redmond Road, south of N.E. 40th Street and West of 172nd Avenue N.E., EXCEPT that portion thereof already annexed by Bellevue City Ordinance # 3424.

Together with: That portion of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 24, Township 25 North Range 5 East. W.M. Lying Southeasterly of Bellevue-Redmond Road. All situate in King County, Washington.
