ORDINANCE NO. 7271

AN ORDINANCE extending the deadline of the interim road adequacy standards, amending Ordinance 6677, Section 5 and K.C.C. 20.66.040 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6677, Section 5 and K.C.C. 20.66.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Duration. The interim road adequacy standards shall be in effect until the King County Council adopts permanent standards or ((~~August 1, 1985~~)) December 31, 1985 whichever is sooner.

SECTION 2. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 10th day of July, 1985.
