ORDINANCE NO. 7294

An ordinance relating to traffic control, prohibiting parking from sunset to sunrise on both sides of 2nd Street Southeast from "T" Street Southeast to a point 420 feet east of "V" Street Southeast, and amending King County Ordinance 5292, Schedule 15.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to traffic engineering studies, and as authorized by RCW 46.90, Schedule 15 of King County Ordinance 5292 which prohibits parking at certain times along county roads, is amended to add the following location:

2ND STREET SOUTHEAST, ON BOTH SIDES, FROM "T" STREET SOUTHEAST TO A POINT 420 FEET EAST OF "V" STREET SOUTHEAST.

SECTION 2: Signs posted to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority.

SECTION 3: Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor, and the punishment shall be provided by the laws of the State of Washington.
