ORDINANCE NO. 7297

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$100,000 for the construction of a traffic signal at 32nd Avenue South and South 200th Street, amending Ordinance No. 7027, Section 83, Attachment No. 1, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$100,000 in the County Road Construction Fund for the construction of a signal at 32nd Avenue South and South 200th Street, CIP Project No. 301085, from a transfer from the Cost Model Contingency, CIP Project No. 999386.

SECTION 2. The project information sheets attached hereto, are hereby approved and adopted amending Ordinance No. 7027, Section 83, Attachment No. 1.

SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
